Residential Accessible Design (RAD) Renovations is a program that works alongside community members (*below income cut-off points*) to finance renovation projects that address mobility needs. Though they do not directly fund projects, they provide home environment assessments, design and drafting of construction drawings, assistance in locating renovation funding, project management, and client support. They will also assess building plans with regard to accessibility for free. Their program is premised on the idea that, with the right supports, people can lead fulfilling lives in their communities.

Income cut-offs are as follows:

- \$46,500 for a single individual
- \$55,000 for a couple
- \$60,000 for families with one child
- \$65,000 for families with two children
- \$70,000 for families with three children
- Various structures for families with adult children or dependent parents, please apply or contact the team for additional information
